EXPERIENCE LEVEL

- Advanced Beginner

MATERIALS

- Brushed Suri (67% Baby Suri, 22% Merino, 11% Bamboo; 50g/142yds): 1 hank
- Size 5 (3.75mm) double pointed needles, or size needed to obtain gauge
- Size 5 (3.75.mm) 16" circular needles, or size needed to obtain gauge
- Size 7 (4.5mm) 16" circular needle, or size needed to obtain gauge
- Stitch marker
- Tapestry needle

SIZES

- One

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

- Circumference: 20"
- Height: 9" (unrolled)

GAUGE

- In stockinette, 16 sts and 32 rows = 4" using smallest needles

BLUE SKY FIBERS

*: repeat the directions between the asterisks as many times as indicated

NOTES: Change to dpns when stitches no longer fit comfortably on circular needle.

HAT

With larger circ ndl CO 80 sts. Pm and join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts.

RND 1: k.

 $\underline{\text{NEXT RND}}$: change to smaller circ ndl and rep rnd 1 until piece meas 7 ½".

CROWN DECREASE

 $\underline{\text{RND 1 (DEC)}}$: *k8, k2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (72 sts)

RND 2: k.

 $\underline{\text{RND 3 (DEC)}}$: *k7, k2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (64 sts)

RND 4: k.

 $\underline{\text{RND 5 (DEC)}}$: *k6, k2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (56 sts)

RND 6: k.

 $\underline{\text{RND 7 (DEC)}}$: *k5, k2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (46 sts)

RND 8: k.

 $\underline{\text{RND 9 (DEC)}}$: *k4, k2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (40 sts)

RND 10: k.

 $\frac{\text{RND 11 (DEC): } \text{*k3, k2tog; rep from * to end of rnd.}}{\text{(32 sts)}}$

<u>Rnd 12: k</u>.

Rnd 13 (dec): *k2, k2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (24 sts)

RND 14: k.

 $\underline{\text{RND } 15 \text{ (DEC)}}$: *k1, k2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (16 sts)

RND 16: k.

RND 17 (DEC): *k2tog; rep from * to end of rnd. (8 sts)

Cut yarn leaving an 8" tail, with tapestry needle thread through rem sts and pull to close.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Block as desired.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS: Hand wash or dry clean. Wash in tepid water using a mild soap. Do not twist. Shape and dry flat on a towel. Store your little treasure neatly folded, after all, it may be a family heirloom.
